We believe that children learn best when they have time and space to be curious and explore the world around them. We believe play fosters self-esteem, confidence, and a desire to discover and find out.

We respect and value each child's right to play and learn at their own pace. Educators respond to children in their play through spontaneous and planned experiences.

We provide extended periods of uninterrupted play and foster learning dispositions of curiosity, wonder, creativity, persistence, resilience, imagination, and problem solving through learning invitations and a stimulating and challenging learning environment.

We believe all forms of play help children learn and grow. We value and encourage children to develop social skills and empathy to help them play and learn with others.
